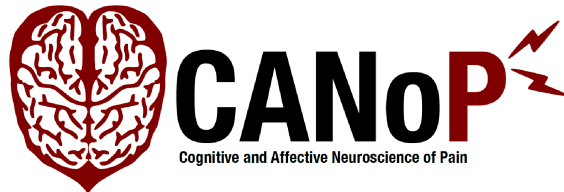


**SECOND MEETING of the**
