#### **SIG Members and Meetings**

# Annual meeting and retreat of the SIG Pain Psychology 27.05.2025

The annual meeting of the SIG pain psychology took place on the 27<sup>th</sup> of May 2025 in the clinic Barmelweid, organized by Ursula Galli and initiated by Manfred Koch. The therapeutic concepts and locations of the clinic were presented by Joran Ronel and his multiprofessional team and gave us an impression about the various therapeutic possibilities, including psychotherapy, psychiatry, arts therapy and music therapy. The prolonged SIG-meeting was dedicated to the discussion and intervision between clinicians, especially on the topic "Long- and Post-Covid- in Pain Psychotherapy".

### 2-day-Course (18 hours) of the SIG Pain Psychology

The 2-days course in Pain Psychotherapy (Patronage SPS), which was developed and organized by our SIG, took place for the fourth time in November in Nottwil on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th November 2024. It contains 18 of the 80hours needed to receive the title «Pain Specialist SPS» in a modular way, by attending 50 of the 80 hours of the original Pain Course in Nottwil/Lucerne and completing it with 30 hours in terms of our 2-days course as well as 12 additional units (for example via 3 meetings of the SAPPM «Arbeitsgruppe Chronischer Schmerz»).

The course was once again fully booked and the feedbacks very positive.
